**WHEREAS**, the Atlantic County Improvement Authority (hereinafter referred to as the “Authority”) is a political subdivision of the State of New Jersey and an instrumentality of the County of Atlantic (hereinafter referred to as “County”), established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:37A-54, the Authority is empowered to undertake the necessary measures necessary to implement and fulfill the purposes set forth therein; and

**RESOLUTION OF THE ATLANTIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT  
AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO  
EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER WITH NERI'S CONSTRUCTION FOR  
THE DEMOLITION OF 108 S. ALBION PLACE IN ATLANTIC CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Atlantic County Improvement Authority, hereafter, the "Authority", is a political subdivision of the State of New Jersey and an instrumentality of Atlantic County, established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, by previous resolution adopted on March 12, 2026, the Board of Commissioners authorized an extension of the shared service agreement with Atlantic City (hereafter the "City") for the Authority to provide Project Management services related to the City-Wide Demolition Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlantic City Bureau of Licensing has determined that the residential structure located at 108 S. Albion Place, Block 34, Lot 5 is in violation of the Uniform Construction code as an unsafe structure, Chapter 104 of the City Code entitled: Buildings Abandoned and Chapter 108 of the City code entitled: Buildings Unfit and is an Imminent Hazard; and

**WHEREAS**, both the uniform Construction Code and Chapter 108 of the City Code provide for the demolition of the structure as a remedy to the violations; and

**WHEREAS**, based on that determination the City requested that the Authority proceed with the demolition of the property in accordance with the above referenced agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 20, 2026 the Authority received responses to its solicitation for the demolition of the property and seven (7) responses were received with fees ranging from \$65,998.90.00 to \$116,473.50; and

**WHEREAS**, staff and the City reviewed the responses, determined that the lowest bid submitted by Neri's Construction is responsive and the bidder demonstrates the requisite capabilities; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends that the Authority proceed with the execution of an agreement with Neri's Construction for an amount not-to exceed \$65,998.90 in accordance with their bid submission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Atlantic County Improvement Authority authorized the Executive Director to execute an agreement with Neri's Construction for an amount not-to exceed \$65,998.90 for the Demolition of the residential structure located at 108 S. Albion Place, Block 34, Lot 5 April 14th, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to award Neri's Construction located additional stucco covered asbestos siding on the property and submitted a Change Order for its removal and disposal in the amount of \$15,071.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the awarded contract on April 14th included a contingency in the amount of \$5,999.90, leaving a shortage of \$9,071.10 of the requested Change Order

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the Atlantic County Improvement Authority that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a Change Order with Neri's Construction in the amount of \$9,071.10 for new not-to exceed contract amount \$75,070.00 for the Demolition of the residential structure located at 108 S. Albion Place, Block 34, Lot 5.

**WHEREAS**, the Authority, is a political subdivision of the State of New Jersey and an instrumentality of Atlantic County, established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:37A-54 a purpose of the Authority is to plan, initiate and carry out redevelopment projects for the elimination, and for the prevention of the development or spread of blighted, deteriorated or deteriorating areas and also to assist local governmental entities in the construction of public facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pleasantville ("City") is a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey with offices located at 18 North 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Pleasantville, New Jersey 08232; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is desirous of renovating an existing warehouse located at 121 W. Park Avenue, Pleasantville, New Jersey 08232, ("Project") so as construct and create a Senior Multi-Purpose Center; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 4th, 2026 the Authority received four (4) bids ranging from a high of \$2,139,500 submitted by Weatherby to a low of \$1,569,700 submitted by R. Maxwell Construction; and

**WHEREAS**, Authority staff, having reviewed Maxwell's required bid documents and finding all in order recommends awarding a contract to R. Maxwell in the amount of \$1,569,7000

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Commissioners of the Atlantic County Improvement Authority hereby authorize the Executive Director to amend a Shared Services Agreement with the City of Pleasantville to include a construction contract with R. Maxwell Construction in the amount of \$1,569,700.00 for new total agreement amount of \$1,823,900.00.

AUTHORIZING PROCUREMENT OF ELECTRIC SUPPLY THROUGH AN  
ELECTRONIC REVERSE AUCTION**

**WHEREAS**, the **Atlantic County Improvement Authority** (hereinafter the “Authority”) is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, organized and existing under the County Improvement Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq., and is authorized pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., to procure goods and services through competitive procurement processes; and

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2018, c. 156 amended the Local Public Contracts Law to authorize the use of electronic procurement, including reverse auctions, as a permissible method of public bidding; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.7, promulgated by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services, establish the rules under which a local unit, including a county improvement authority, may conduct a reverse auction for the procurement of energy supply, and a properly conducted reverse auction under these regulations satisfies the public bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.7(a), the electronic procurement platform vendor utilized for the auction is registered with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“BPU”) as an “energy agent” under the New Jersey Electric Discount and Energy Competition Act of 1999 (“EDECA”), and only BPU-licensed third-party suppliers shall be eligible to bid; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.7(e), the governing body of a local unit may authorize its purchasing agent to award a contract to the successful bidder shortly after bids are closed if the price is below a specified amount; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has determined that procuring electric supply through a competitive electronic reverse auction will provide cost savings, transparency, and budget certainty for the Authority;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the **Atlantic County Improvement Authority** as follows:

1. The Authority authorizes the procurement of third-party **electric** supply for all eligible Authority accounts through an electronic reverse auction conducted in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.
2. The supply product shall be structured as a **fixed-energy product with capacity and transmission charges passed through at cost**.
3. The contract term shall not exceed **twenty-four (24) months**.
4. The supply rate awarded shall not exceed **\$0.099 per kWh**.
5. The reverse auction shall be conducted using an electronic procurement platform operated by a vendor that is registered with the BPU as an “energy agent” pursuant to EDECA, and only BPU-licensed third-party energy suppliers shall be eligible to submit bids.
6. All applicable notice, advertisement, and procedural requirements set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.6 and 5:34-5.7 shall be satisfied prior to the conduct of the auction.
7. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.7(e), the Executive Director of the Authority, or designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the successful bidder shortly after bids are closed, provided the awarded price does not exceed the not-to-exceed price set forth in Paragraph 4 above. The Executive Director shall report back to the Authority with the auction results.

8. The Executive Director of the Authority, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution, including the resulting energy supply agreement and any related rider documents.
9. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2018, c. 156 amended the Local Public Contracts Law to authorize the use of electronic procurement, including reverse auctions, as a permissible method of public bidding; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.7, promulgated by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services, establish the rules under which a local unit, including a county improvement authority, may conduct a reverse auction for the procurement of energy supply, and a properly conducted reverse auction under these regulations satisfies the public bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law; and



2. The supply product shall be structured as a **fixed-price product (all-in fixed rate)**.
3. The contract term shall not exceed **thirty-six (36) months**.
4. The supply rate awarded shall not exceed **\$0.88 per therm**.
5. The reverse auction shall be conducted using an electronic procurement platform operated by a vendor that is registered with the BPU as an “energy agent” pursuant to EDECA, and only BPU-licensed third-party energy suppliers shall be eligible to submit bids.
6. All applicable notice, advertisement, and procedural requirements set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.6 and 5:34-5.7 shall be satisfied prior to the conduct of the auction.
7. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.7(e), the Executive Director of the Authority, or designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the successful bidder shortly after bids are closed, provided the awarded price does not exceed the not-to-exceed price set forth in Paragraph 4 above. The Executive Director shall report back to the Authority with the auction results.

**WHEREAS**, the Authority is desirous of eliminating the risk of such unreimbursed damages and litigation expenses, if possible, and the Board of Commissioners recognizes the benefit of eliminating these potential economic risks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Atlantic County Improvement Authority that settlement authority in the amount of \$69,055.00 shall be and is hereby extended in order to attempt a resolution of the matters of *Leonard Hooker v. ACIA* and *Nicholas Gonzales v. ACIA*, matters pending in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division, Atlantic County under Docket Nos. ATL-L-1672-24 and ATL-L-231-25, respectively, with there being no admission of liability or responsibility thereby.
